

Annual Report (2022-23)

Prologue:

As early as 2014, the need for a good school to provide quality education to children in the rural areas of Chhaygaon was strongly felt. In response, the visionary members of the NGO *Grameen Sahara*, who have been working toward the sustainable economic development of communities along the southern bank of the Brahmaputra River in Assam, took the initiative to establish one. That's how the GRAMEEN JYOTI ACADEMY came into its existence. From its inception Grameen Jyoti Academy is a co-educational day scholar school.

The school is situated in a plain valley of southern bank of the Brahmaputra River, approximately 26 km away from Guwahati's Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi (LGB) Airport and 35 km from the Guwahati Railway Station. The surrounding community primarily consists of farmers and small-scale business owners.

Mission and Vision of Grameen Jyoti Academy:-

To transform the dream of establishing a quality school into reality, the board members of *Grameen Sahara* (an NGO) began efforts to secure a plot of land measuring 4,588.6 square meters. They undertook the construction of a school building with RCC walls and GI roofing, along with the installation of ceilings and electrical connections.

The school comprises 13 well-sized classrooms, each built in accordance with the specifications outlined in the Affiliation Byelaws. In addition to academic spaces, the school is equipped with essential infrastructure including a library, a composite science laboratory, a computer lab, separate CWSN (Children With Special Needs) toilets for boys and girls, and a playground.

Grameen Jyoti Academy envisions its alumni as individuals who carry a distinct identity—not only through academic excellence but also through exemplary character and behavior. Every student who completes education from GJA is expected to embody values that contribute to making them admirable and responsible citizens of the nation.

To fulfill this vision, the school emphasizes a continuous process of character building, nurturing students to develop integrity, empathy, and a strong moral foundation alongside their education.

Academic Activities / Annual Calendar:

The academic session commences on **1st April** and concludes on **30th March** of the following year. We follow a well-structured **Academic Calendar/School Diary** for each session, incorporating all **scholastic and co-scholastic activities**. Our goal is to ensure timely completion of the prescribed syllabuses of all subjects and classes. Simultaneously, co-scholastic activities are conducted in parallel to make the teaching-learning process of the students stress free and joyful.

To assess the academic and the progress in teaching learning of students, **Periodic Written Tests (PWTs)** and **Term Examinations** were conducted in accordance with the guidelines set by the **Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE)**. Student performance was evaluated through the **Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE)** system. Special emphasis was taken on completing the syllabus as per the split-up syllabus plan prior to each scheduled assessment test.
