Prologue

GJA (Grameen Jyoti Academy) was established in the academic year 2014–15 in response to public demand for a CBSE-affiliated school in the operational area of Grameen Sahara. Founded under the aegis of **Grameen Sahara**, a non-governmental organization committed to addressing a range of social and economic challenges, GJA was envisioned as a platform to harness the immense potential of students. GJA fosters a learning community grounded in shared values, where enthusiasm for learning and a spirit of inquiry are actively encouraged. The school is located approximately 25 kilometers west of Guwahati Airport.

With experienced faculty and comprehensive facilities—including a well-equipped library, computer and science labs, digital classrooms, arts and music rooms, and sports infrastructure—the school fosters intellectual, mental, and physical growth, preparing students to compete confidently with their peers in urban schools.

Special emphasis is placed on completing the syllabus as per the split-up syllabus plan prior to each scheduled assessment.
